# CSFP: Monthly Food Boxes for Senior Citizens

---

## What is CSFP?

The Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP) provides nutritious food to seniors in need over the age of 60 on a monthly basis.

---

## Who is eligible?

Individuals who:

- Are over the age of 60
- Have a monthly income at or below 130% of the Federal Poverty Line (see next page)
- Are residents of Idaho

## What is in the box?

Monthly items can include evaporated milk, cheese, peanut butter, cereal, canned fruits and vegetables, rice, beans, and meat. Items may vary.

---

**Note:** If you qualify for food stamps, or energy assistance, then you qualify for this program. You DO NOT lose your eligibility for food stamps by participating in this program.
