
CSFP: Monthly Food Boxes for Senior Citizens

What is CSFP?

The Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP) provides nutritious food to seniors in need over the age of 60 on a monthly basis.

Who is eligible?

Individuals who:

- Are over the age of 60
- Have a monthly income at or below 130% of the Federal Poverty Line (see next page)
- Are residents of Idaho

What is in the box?

Monthly items can include evaporated milk, cheese, peanut butter, cereal, canned fruits and vegetables, rice, beans, and meat. Items may vary.

Note: If you qualify for food stamps, or energy assistance, then you qualify for this program. You DO NOT lose your eligibility for food stamps by participating in this program.
